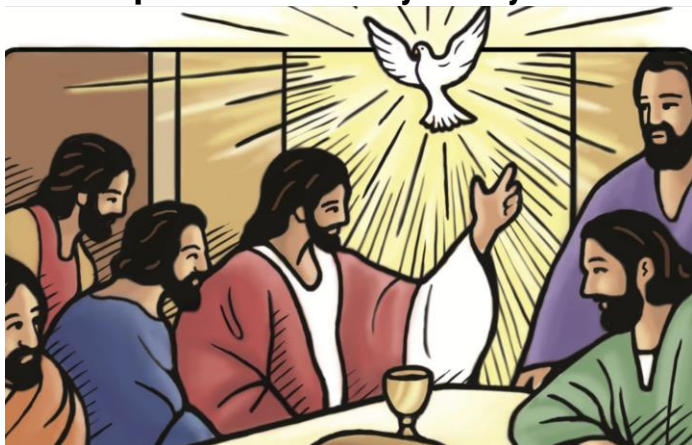

Gospel Reflection

Keep my word!

Keeping another's word requires: attentiveness, care, vigilance, loyalty, and a strength that is gentle and a gentleness that is robust. To keep someone's word in my heart is to be attuned, even to be obedient to its presence there. To keep another's word is to listen and respond to it faithfully; to be faithful to the one who gave my heart a word to keep. When I *fail* in keeping another's word I weaken the spirit of the sharing and damage the bond we had created.

So today we are invited by Jesus to think carefully about the words he has gifted to us – words we are to treasure in our hearts...words we are to live faithfully each day... words we are to share with others... words we are to be obedient to in our life... words we are to be attentive to. These words are words of peace, of love, of joy, of hope, of care, of faith. These are words which are to be cornerstones of our daily living, we are not to be afraid of witnessing to these words each day, in every encounter.
